DROPS "BLACK GLITTER" ON AN UNSUSPECTING POPULATION

ON COBRA MUSIC/FONTANA

SUFFRAJETT, Chicago's unstoppable force of nature, unleashes their next aural onslaught with the highly anticipated *Black Glitter*, hitting the streets January 23 on new indie upstart label Cobra Music/Fontana. This innovative gang of delinquents—Simi (vocals), Jason Chasko (guitar), Kevin Roberts (bass), and Danny Severson (drums)—has earned an abundance of rabid accolades from critics and fans alike.

Hypnotized by the devastatingly provocative front woman Simi, and described as raw, low-fi Afro-punk, garage glam, art punk, mental rock, garage rock and grunge hair metal, it's clear that SUFFRAJETT has carved out a place that's entirely their own and defies description. *Black Glitter* is the embodiment of the SUFFRAJETT way of life—dark, sharp and shiny. It fearlessly proclaims that this is the year Simi crushes the glut of boring bands into a fine powder.

Created from a divergent brew of The Runaways, Tamar-Kali, Motley Crue, Blondie, Diana Ross, Grace Jones, Guns 'n' Roses, and Joan Jett, SUFFRAJETT emerged just three years ago as one of the driving forces in independent rock with their self-titled debut, released on In Music We Trust. Esquire described the offering, recorded in a Manhattan mini-storage space, as a "dirty record about sex and drugs" and dubbed it one of the 21 essential records of 21st century.

Originally formed by Simi, guitarist Chasko (who co-wrote Liz Phair's *whitechocolatespaceegg*) and bassist Roberts in New York, SUFFRAJETT unearthed drummer Severson once the band made to move to Chicago. The band has previously spent their share of time on the road with MC5, The Eagles of Death Metal, Electric Six, Local H and The River Boat Gamblers to name a few.
